If you have 8th graders that are eligible to run in a HS race then they must be entered in the HS race.

In 2006, the Knoxville Track Club and TennesseeRunner.com started an end of the season meet to serve as a Tennessee State Middle School Championship. This meet is not a TSSAA or TMSAA meet. It is considered a post-season meet. The meet is a USATF sanctioned meet.

Beginning in 2007, a series of qualifying meets has been set across the state in which middle schools may attempt to qualify for the State Middle School Meet. The Trailblazer Cross-Country Invitational will serve as the qualifying meet for the Tri-Cities Region. The Slipstream Track Club is serving as the local sponsor for the Tri-Cities Region.

The Tri-Cities Region consists of the following counties:

Claiborne, Hancock, Jefferson, Hamblen, Cocke, Greene, Hawkins, Sullivan, Washington, Unicoi, Carter, and Johnson.

The Top 5 Tennessee middle school teams at the Trailblazer will qualify for the State meet. In addition, the top 25 Tennessee individuals not on one of the five teams will also qualify.
